## Admission

Admission begins on the 1st of February. 25% seats are reserved as per government instruction in Creche which is our entry class.

## The Nursery section- The Stepping Stones

The Nursery section consists of the Creche, K.G. and Prep. The age of admission in Creche is 3 plus as on 1st July and 4 plus in Kindergarten and so on. The section is housed in a separate wing and there is a large playground exclusively for them. The pupils come in casuals. The academic session starts in July. Their work day lasts 5 hours with actual class room studies lasting 1 to 2½ hours. The rest is fun time. The children enjoy cycling, clay modeling, playing, music, hearing stories and rhymes and have leisurely lunches. Regular medical checkups, picnics and visits to the zoo, parks and other places of interest makeup the rest of their curriculum. The little ones are very happy to have visitors; please visit them in the playground.





## The Academic Session

The school follows two academic sessions, one beginning in April and the other in July.

## Classes I to X

The curriculum includes English, Hindi, Art, Maths, Science and Social Studies. In addition to these Sanskrit is the third language from Class-VI onwards. Computer Science is taught from Class-I to VIII as an optional subject.

The school lays emphasis on co-curricular activities like debates, declamation, drawing, painting and outdoor games. The pupils, however, are not tested in these in the CBSE examination.

## Classes XI and XII

The school offers Science and Commerce streams at the +2 level. Any five subjects from the following combinations should be chosen, as options.

- Subject 1: English
- Subjects 2 and 3: Physics and Chemistry **or** Accountancy and Business Studies
- Subject 4: Mathematics **or** Biology **or** Economics **or** Information Practices
- Subject 5: Economics **or** Physical Education





## Inter-House Competitions

To promote games and competitions, the school follows a system of houses. There are 4 houses and every student is a member of one or the other. In all activities, the houses hotly contest against one another, for the Victor's Cup; be it basket ball, volley ball, table tennis, kho-kho, athletics, debates, declamation, poetry recitation, science or essays.

For the swift and the supple, 'Gymnastics' is the favorite choice, with the better ones among them making it to 'the ring of fire' and vaulting 'the wooden horse'.





## Library

The School Library is a treasure trove of over 7,000 books, magazines and journals drawn from all over the world. The books are both academic and non-academic and in keeping with the level of each class. Children of classes III and above can draw a maximum of 2 books at a time.

## Teaching Aids

An A.V. Room, equipped with a DVD player, a 'SHARP' O.H. Projector, a library of cassettes and CDs on various subjects, enhances the joy of learning.



## Laboratories

Large, spacious and fully equipped labs for physics, chemistry, biology and computers provide thorough practical knowledge.







## Sports & Extra-Curriculars

'A sound mind dwells in a sound body'. 80% of our campus is playground and the pupils make the most of it. Regular games are organized both during and after school. Students are encouraged to participate in intra and inter school activities and periods are set aside for them. 24th December is observed as the sports day and includes Mass P.T., March Past, dances, athletics, gymnastics and aerobics.
